## **HOW TO GET HERE**

**BY ROAD:** Caernarfon is just 20 minutes from the main A55 Expressway, giving easy access from Anglesey and the North Wales Coast. There are three large public car parks within 10 minutes walk of the station in addition to a small car park at the station itself. Follow the brown signs through the town.

**BY TRAIN:** The nearest mainline station is Bangor which is well served by trains from Crewe, Manchester and London. Both Arriva Trains Wales and Virgin Trains serve Bangor. Visit www.arrivatrainswales.co.uk for details. There is a regular bus service between Bangor station and Caernarfon taking approximately 30 minutes.

**BY BUS:** Caernarfon is well served by bus and coach services. From the main bus stops, walk towards the Castle Square. Cross the square, heading towards the castle. Turn left down the hill in front of the castle, then left again. The station is approximately 200 yards along this road.

Rhyd Ddu and Waunfawr stations are both on 'Snowdon Sherpa' bus routes which provides access to / from Beddgelert, Betws y Coed and Porthmadog.



2008 is the Fiftieth Anniversary of the construction of NG/G16 Beyer-Garratt No.143 (Works No.7868) - now running on the Welsh Highland Railway (C)

No.143 was the last Garratt locomotive built by Beyer, Peacock at Gorton Works in Manchester. Our unique fleet of locomotives includes 'K1' - the world's first Garratt - also built by Beyer, Peacock.

So what better way to celebrate the distinguished history of this famous company than to dedicate North Wales' Garratt-powered railway's September enthusiast event to this anniversary.

### WHAT'S ON OVER THE WEEKEND?

Well, first of all, you should be able to see at least fifty Garratts. As well as our own locomotives, we will be having visiting engines on 56½", 15" and 7½" gauges - including two 'K1' replicas, *Mount Kilimanjaro* and Beyer, Peacock's own shunting locomotive. The newly extended 16<sup>mm</sup> Garratt Owners' demonstration layout will fill nearly half of Dinas Goods Shed - and they expect to have well over twenty operating locos in action. There will also be a 5" gauge ride on a live steam railway in the car park at Caernarfon Station.

In addition to this, many more static models will be on display, including locos built for Belgian Congo Rhodesia, and East Africa. The loco shed and workshops will be open so that you will be able to see the progress on rebuilding No.138 - and what each piece looks like when they are separated from each other!

We have arranged for two extensive collections of loco, boiler and works plates to attend, together with photos and models of the original locos. Of course, the history of our own locos will not be ignored, with a written history on display, together with photos of them in their original homes. We are also collecting a broad range of material covering everything from Herbert William Garratt's original design, to photos of the many types of Garratts produced.

We will run an intensive timetable of seven trains over the current length of the line to Rhyd Ddu, with additional shuttle trains from Caernarfon to Waunfawr. This is our last chance to provide this level of service for some time - as trains will soon be running through Beddgelert and the Aberglaslyn Pass to Porthmadog - so make sure you don't miss this special weekend!
